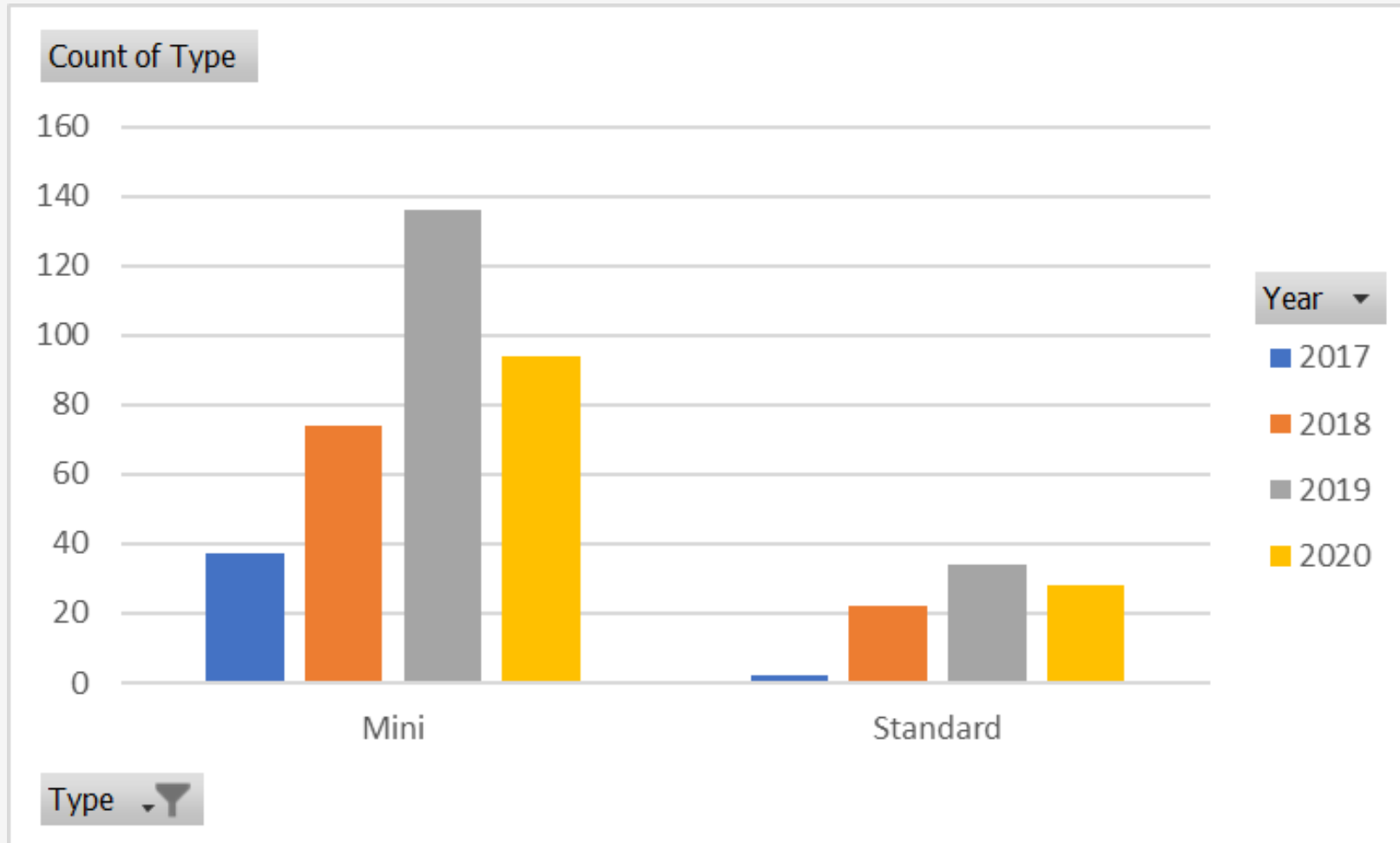


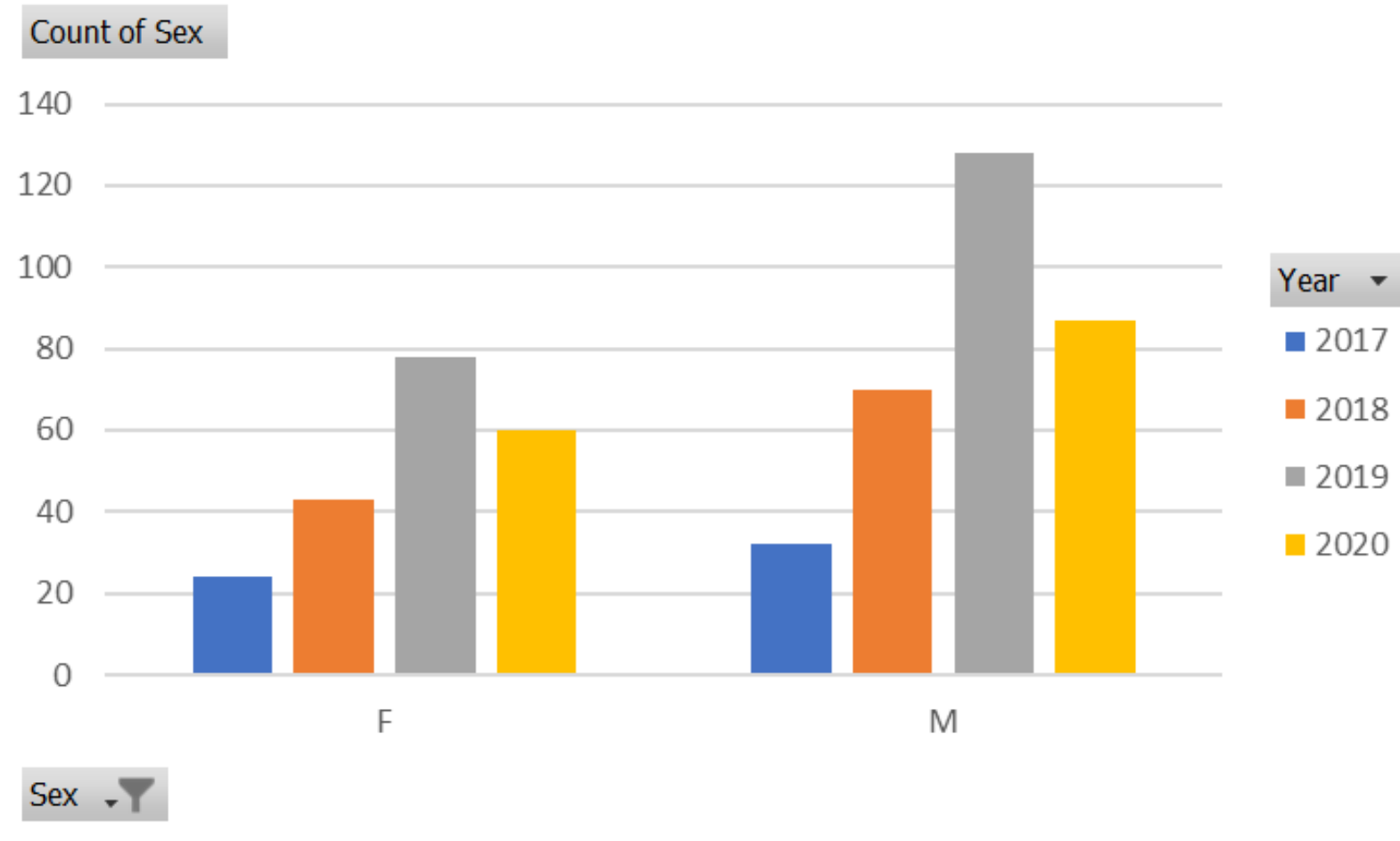

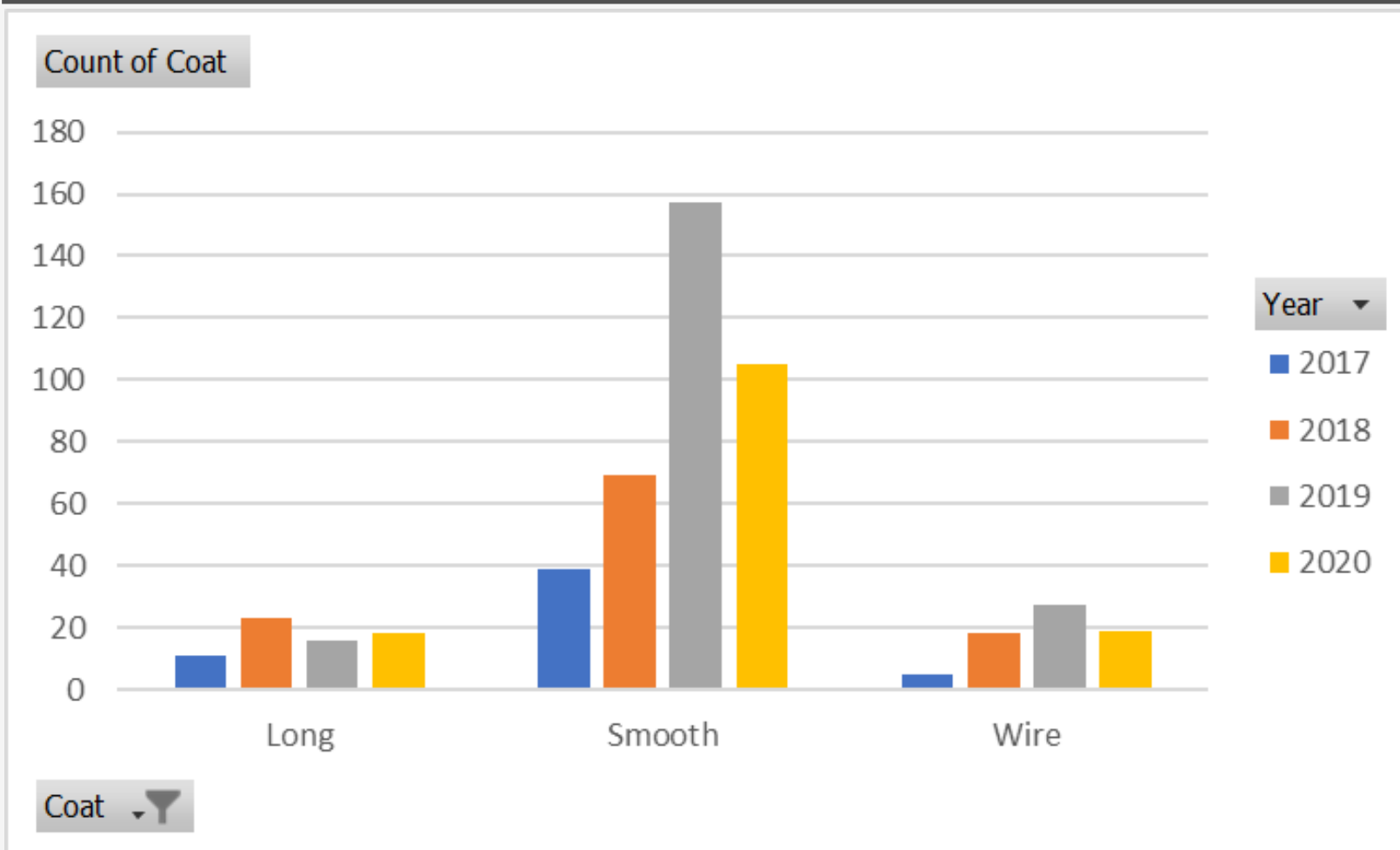
NUMBER OF DOGS BY SIZE & YEAR



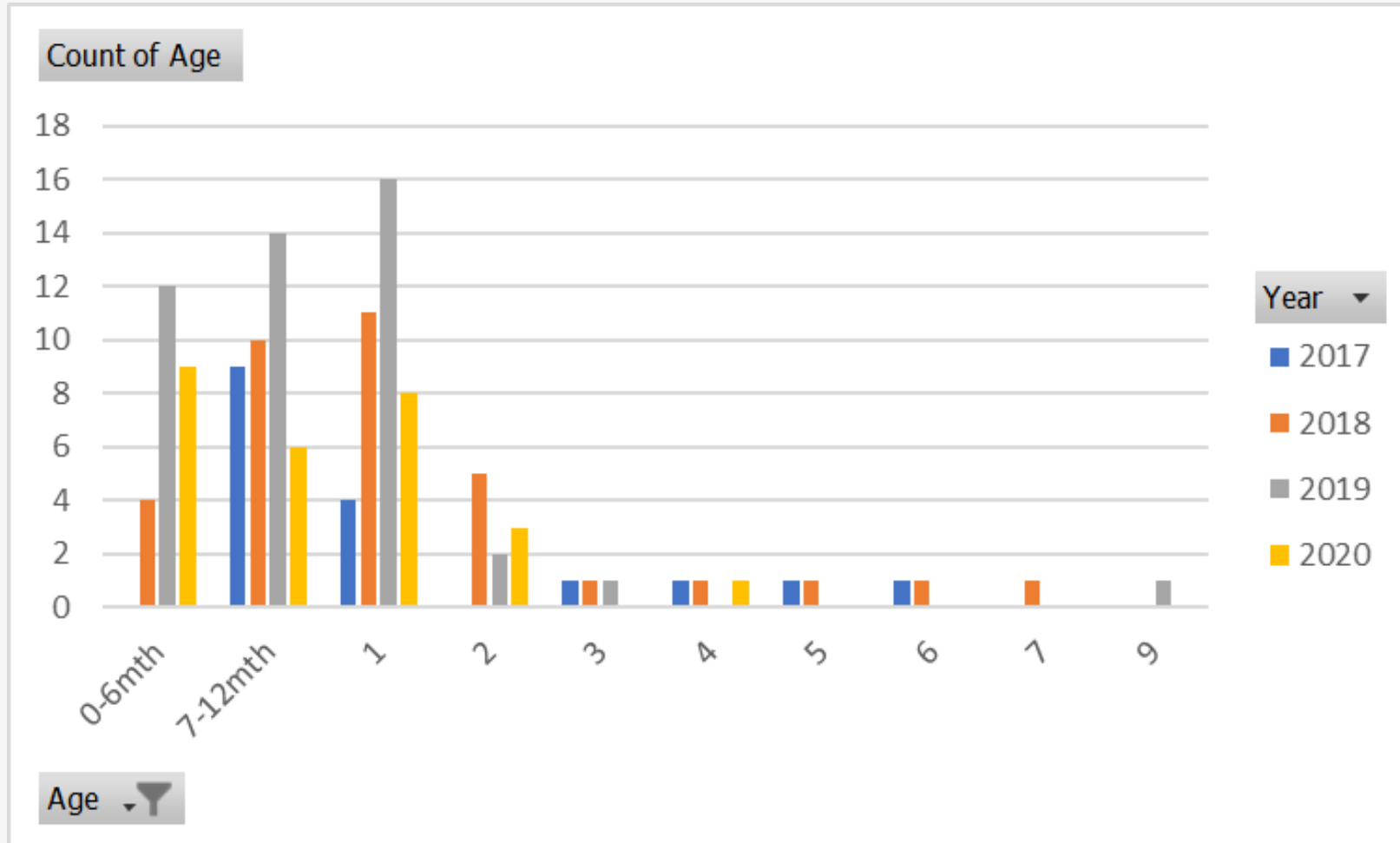
NUMBER OF DOGS BY SEX & YEAR



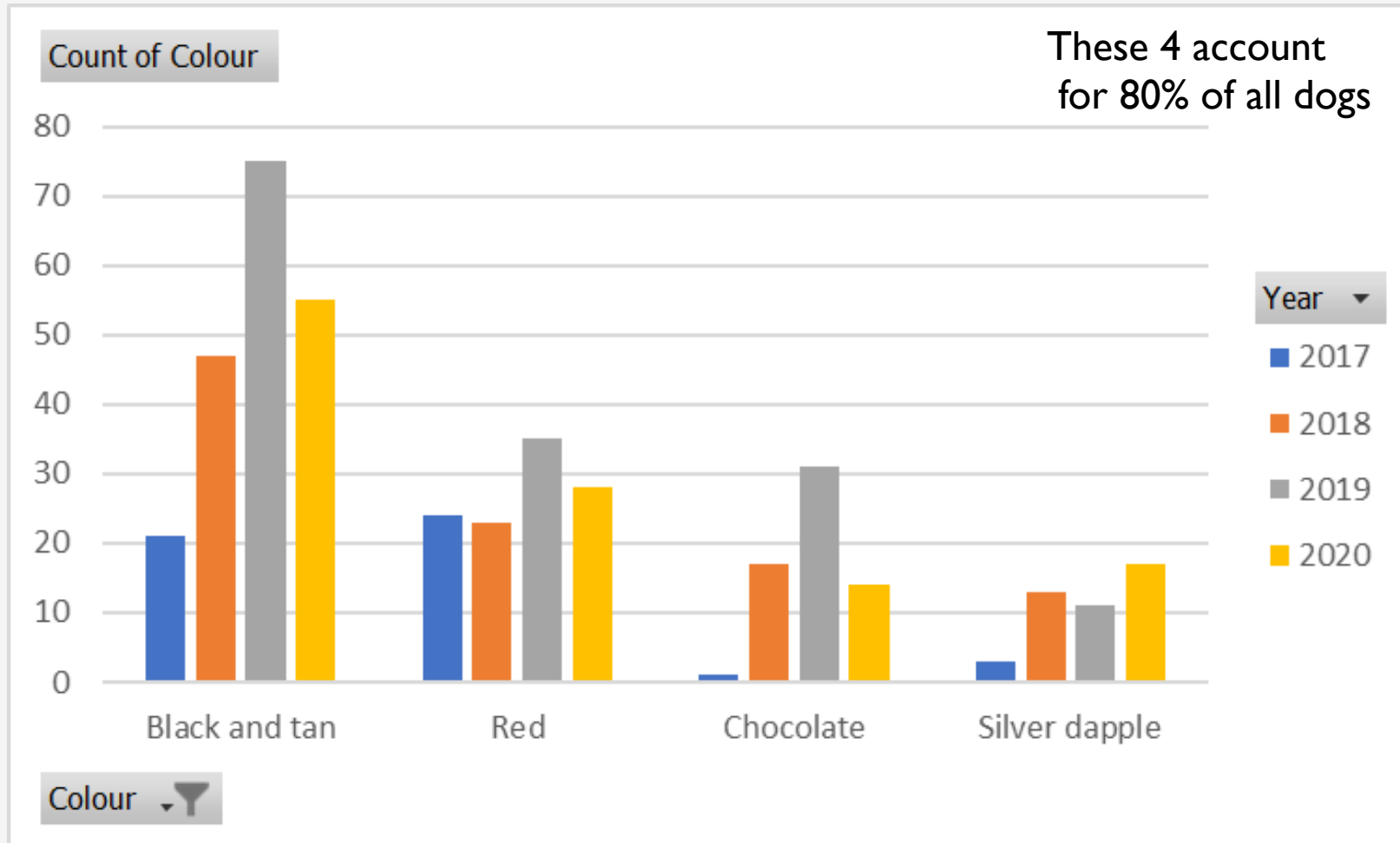
NUMBER OF DOGS BY COAT & YEAR



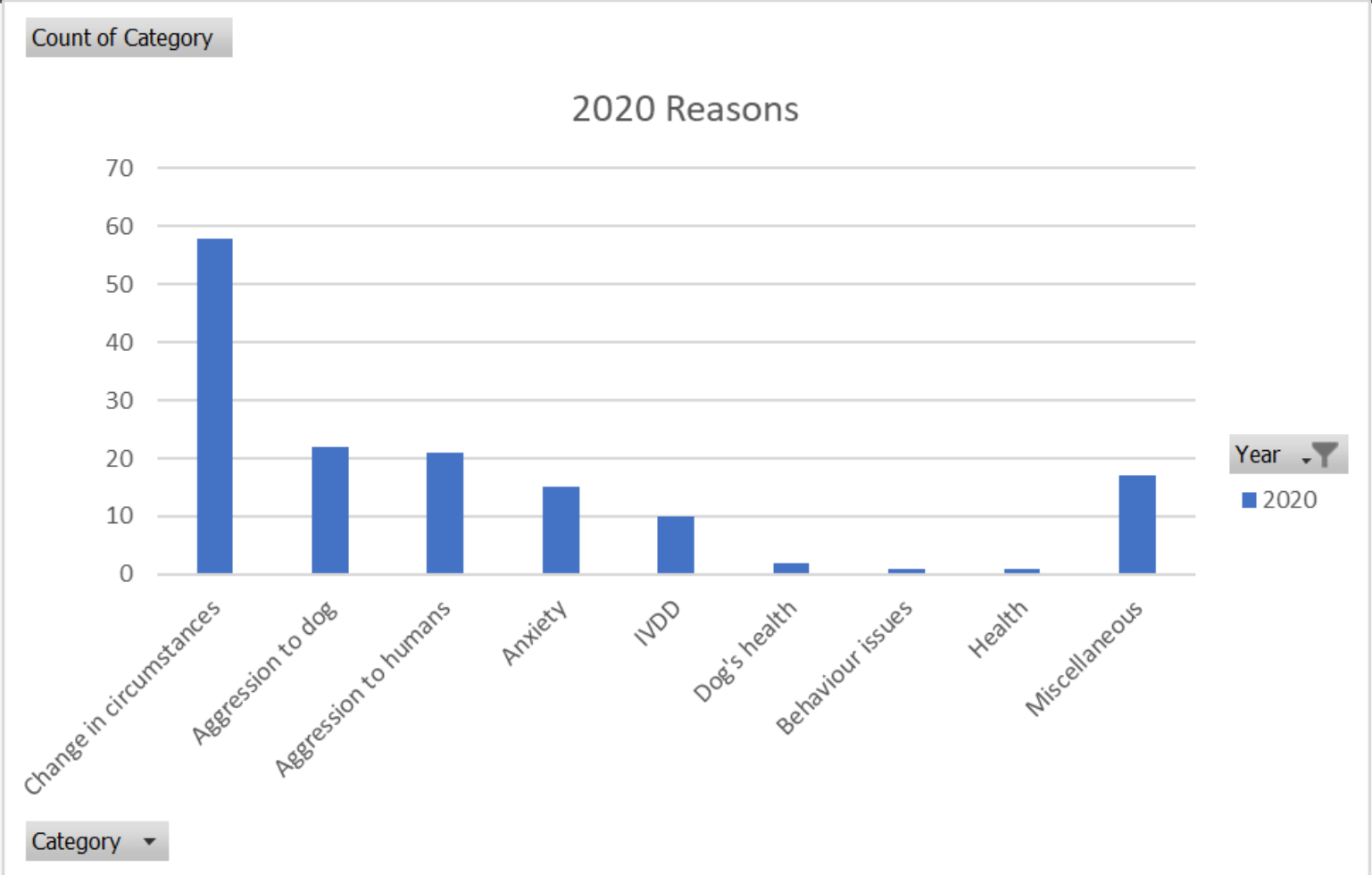
NUMBER OF DOGS BY AGE & YEAR



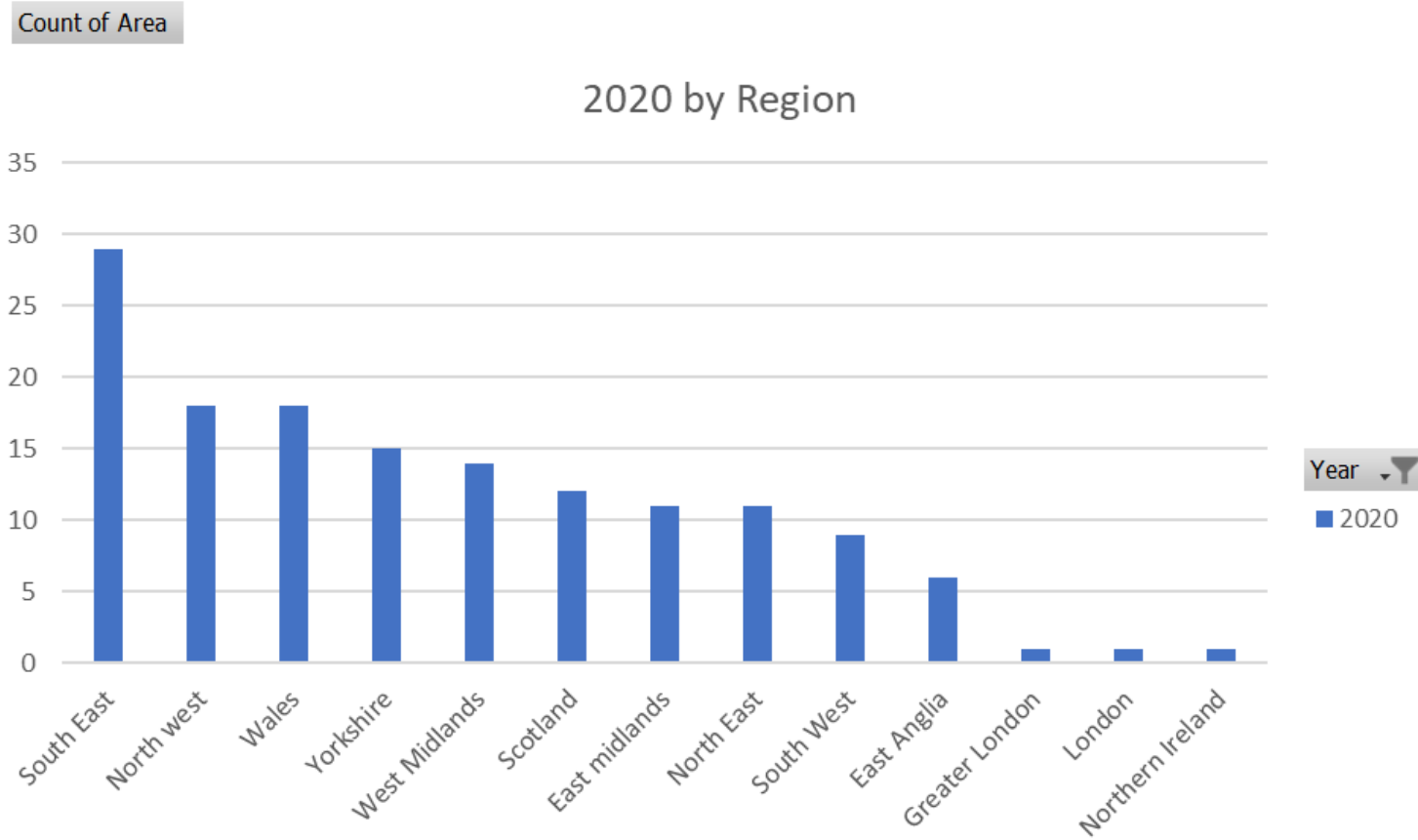
NUMBER OF DOGS BY COLOUR & YEAR



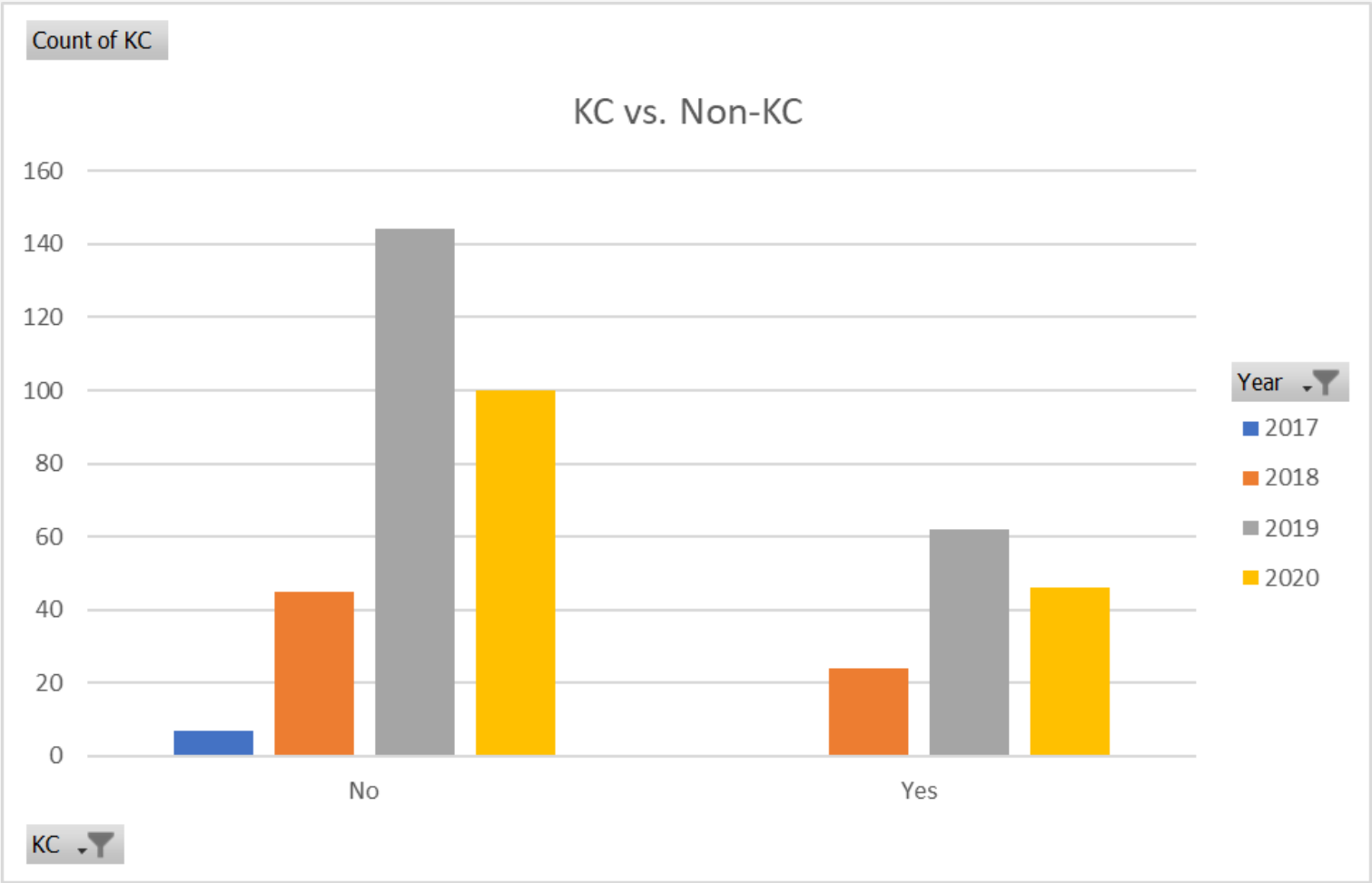
REASONS FOR RESCUE/REHOME 2020



RESCUE/REHOME BY REGION 2020

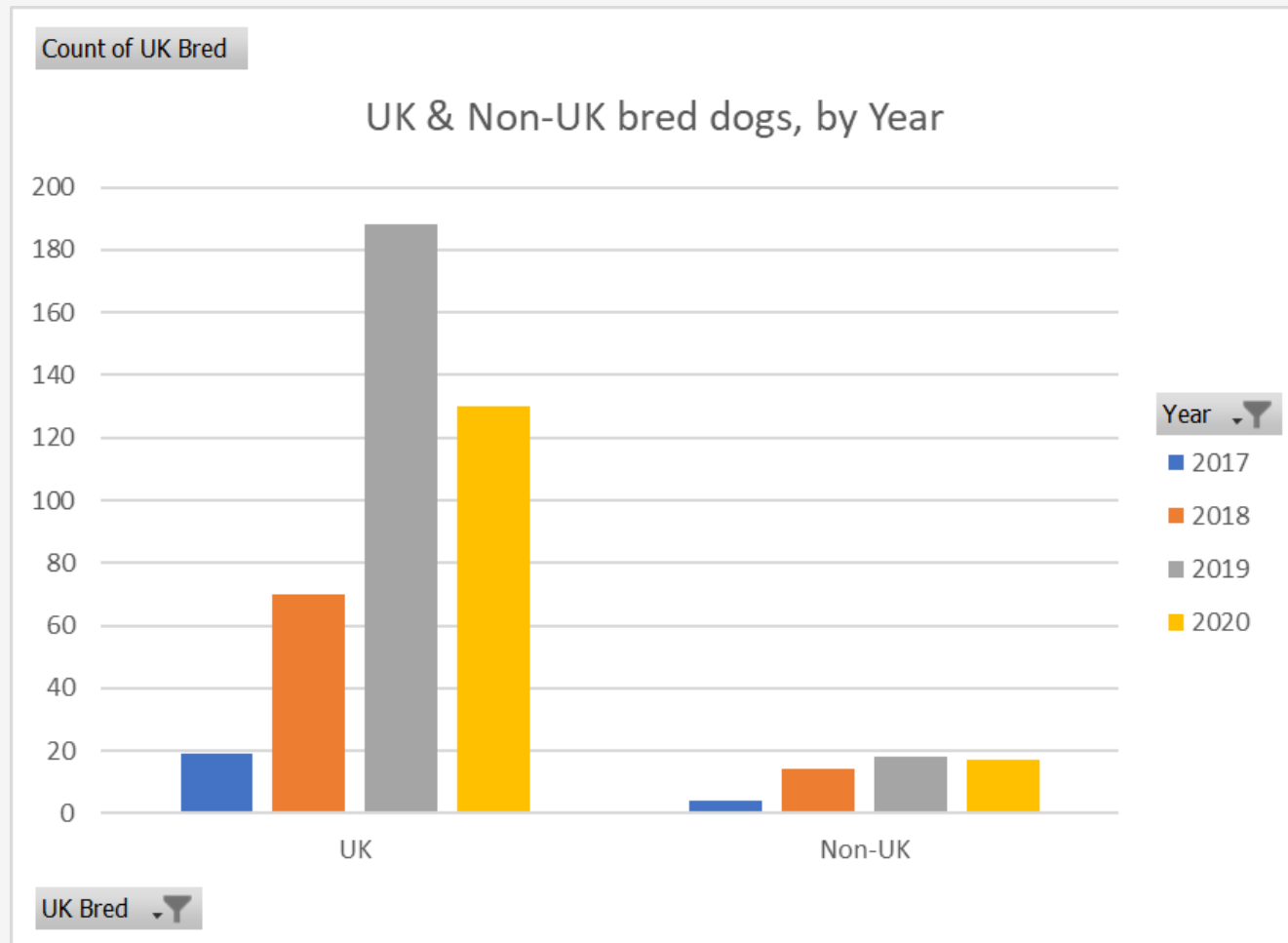


KC VS. NON-KC

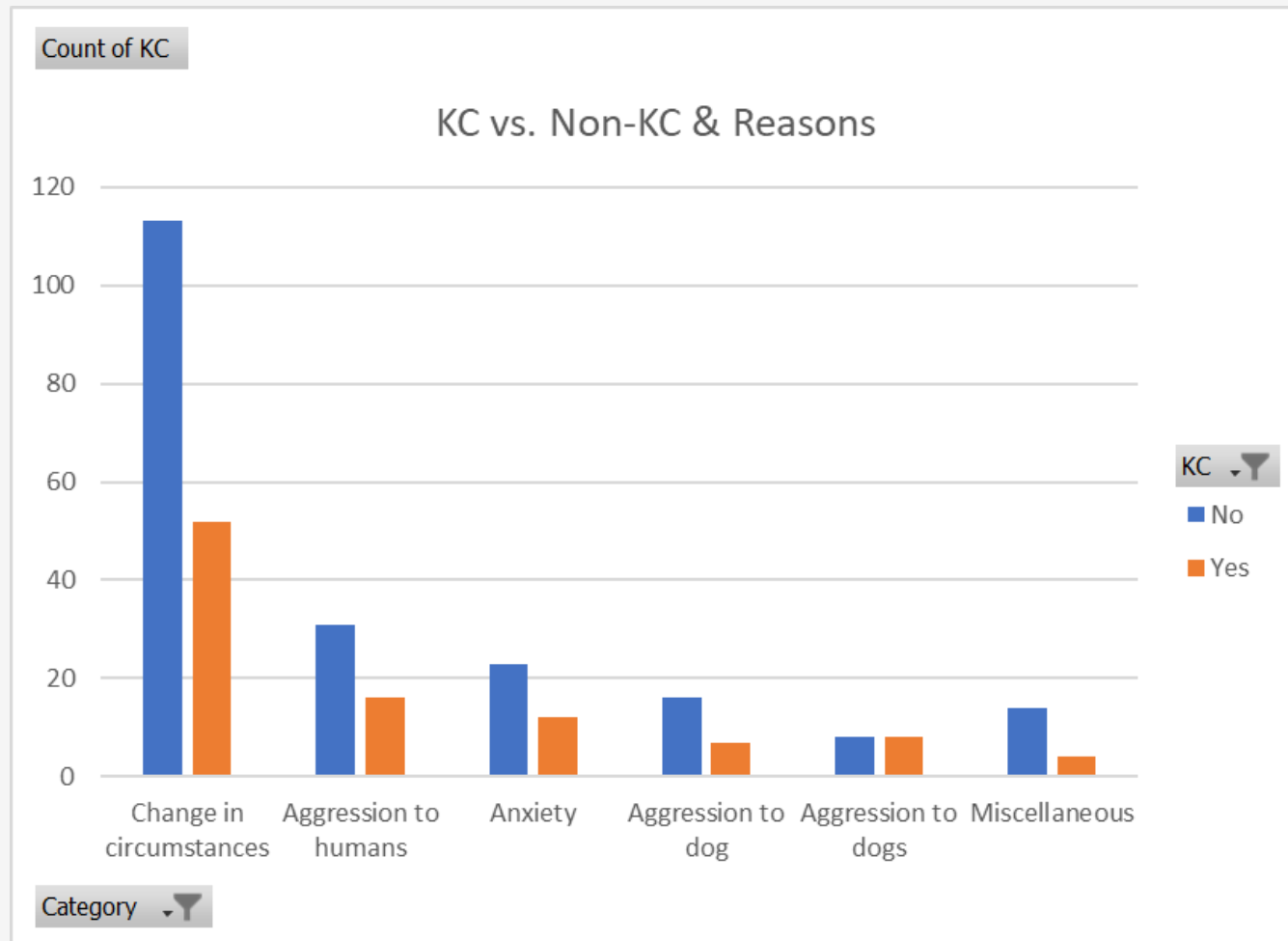


70% were not KC-Registered

UK VS. NON-UK BRED

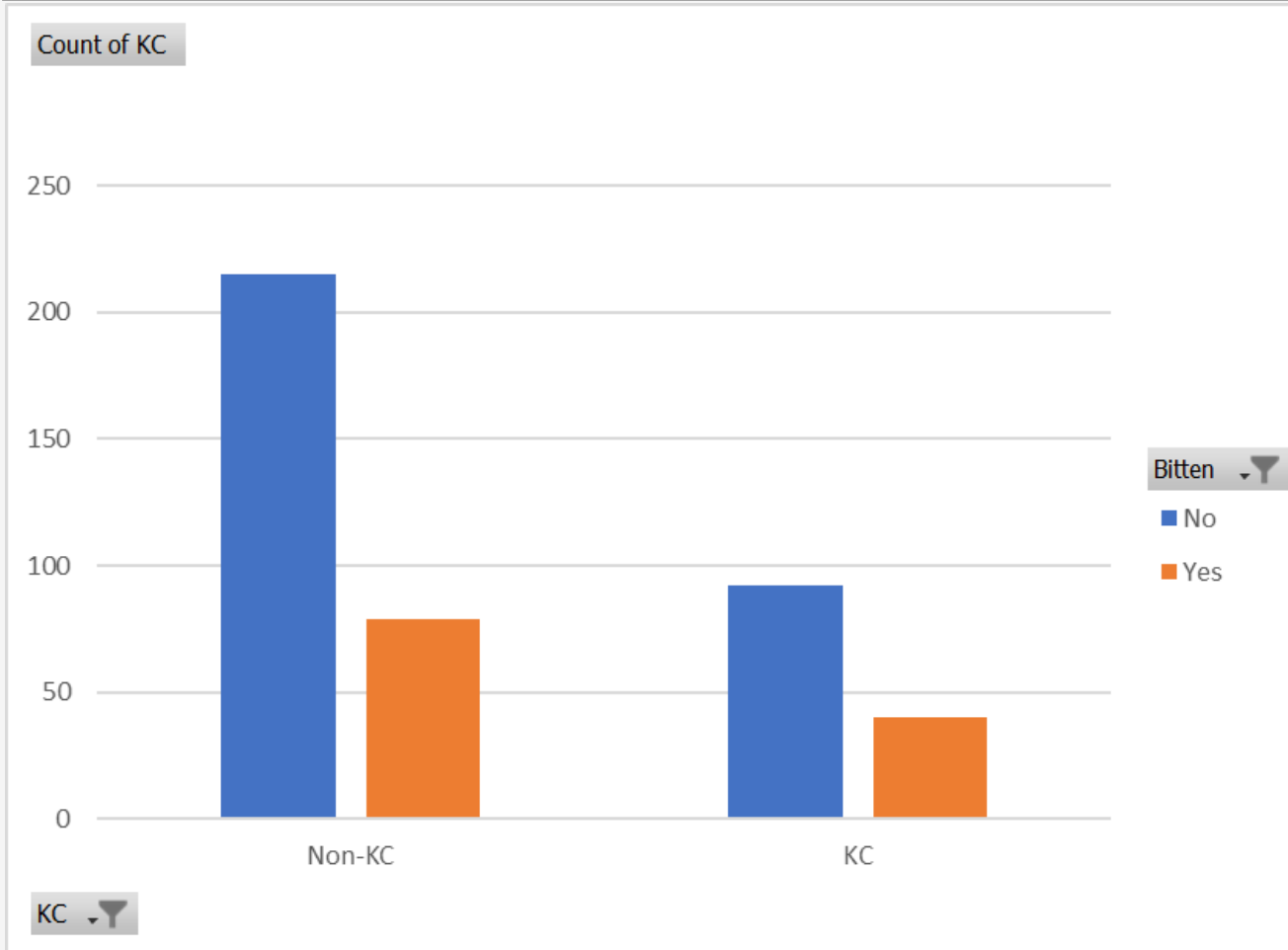


KC VS. NON-KC & REASONS FOR RESCUE/REHOMING

than KC registered ones

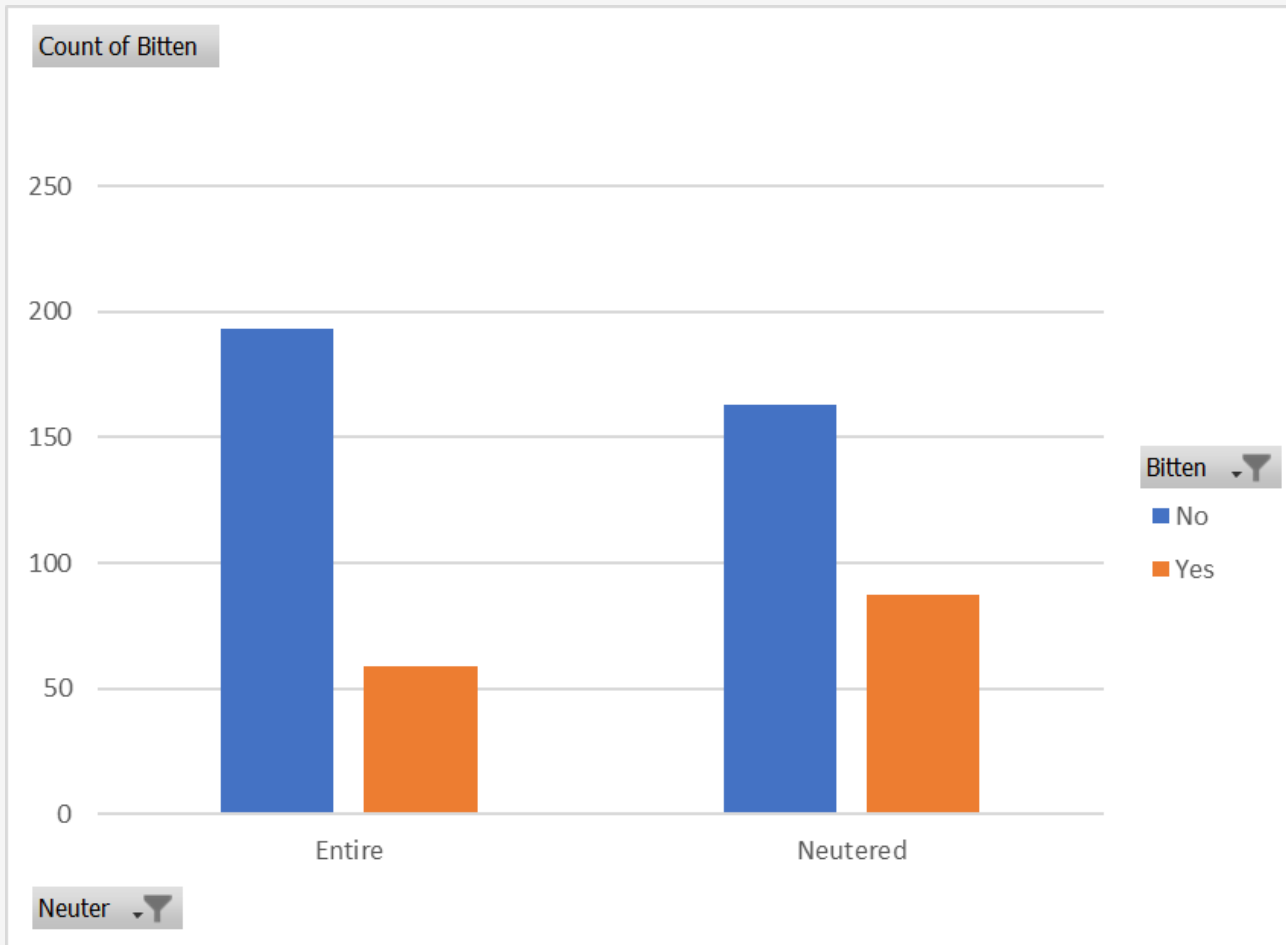
KC & NON-KC VS. BITTEN



Odds ratio	0.8451
95 % CI:	0.5378 to 1.3280
z statistic	0.730
Significance level	P = 0.4656

There is no difference in Bite history of KC vs. Non-KC

NEUTER STATUS VS. BITTEN



Odds ratio	1.7460
95 % CI:	1.1812 to 2.5809
z statistic	2.795
Significance level	P = 0.0052

Neutered dogs were nearly twice as likely to have bitten, compared with entire Dachshunds
